### Organization Overview

The George Snow Scholarship Fund is dedicated to helping deserving students within the community achieve their career goals through their pursuit of higher education. By providing financial assistance and a host of supplementary support services, they ensure that scholarship recipients have the resources they need to thrive academically.

Since its inception in 1982, the organization has awarded over \$26 million in educational grants.

### Funding Impact

Quantum Foundation's \$100,000 two-year award is to support students who have chosen to pursue a degree in a health profession while enrolled at Palm Beach State College, Palm Beach Atlantic University, or Florida Atlantic University.

**2022-2023**

10 graduating seniors received scholarships. The cohort was comprised of 5 Black males, 5 females from Latine, Black, and Asian heritage.

**2023-2024**

30 scholarship candidates will be interviewed on April 29, 2024. Awards for the 2024 Quantum Foundation Health Professions Scholarships will be made on May 17.

### Quantum support through the years...

## Beyond The Ribbons

On March 2, **The Pink Queen Foundation** held its 2nd Annual Cancer Health Summit "Beyond The Ribbons" in partnership with The Promise Fund of Florida with the aim to equip and empower attendees with resources and knowledge necessary to navigate cancer care for themselves or their loved ones.

The FREE event brought together 143 survivors, caregivers, and advocates seeking insights into cancer care and management, and highlighted the support of 14 sponsors and services of 17 vendors and community partners.

The summit featured Breast Surgical Oncologists, Dr. Jane Mendez M.D and Dr. Anouchka Coste D.O, as keynote speakers and offered sessions on mental health, nutrition and wellness, and advocacy awareness. In addition, health screenings for cervical, colon, and prostate cancer were provided to pre-registered participants by the UM Sylvester Cancer Center team.

The gathering is a true testament to The Pink Queen Foundation's commitment to fostering a supportive community for those impacted by cancer.

## Grand Opening!

The Friendship Health Clinic opened on March 14 at **Friendship Missionary Baptist Church** in partnership with **Integrated Healthcare Systems**.

The walk-in mini-clinic will offer behavioral health, primary healthcare, and case management services each Wednesday and Friday from 9am-3pm to uninsured members of the community.

Additionally, both community partners have joined forces with Rose Trolley to ensure patients have access to transportation for getting to and from their appointments, the Robalo Pharmacy for medication delivery, and the Health Council of Southeast Florida for rapid testing and education.
